

## **Interpreting Your MTLE Score Report**

1 Subtest Status

If you received a scaled score at or above the "Minimum Passing Score," you will received a "Passed" status. If you receive a scaled score below the "Minimum Passing Score," you will receive a "Not passed" status. To pass the entire test, you must pass each subtest.

2 Your Subtest Score

The total subtest score is based on the number of raw score points earned on each section; the proportion accounted for by each section, if applicable; and the scaling of that score. Raw scores are converted to a scale of 100 to 300.

3 Passing Score

To pass each subtest, you must obtain the minimum passing score listed or higher.

4 Subtest Diagnostic Information

Diagnostic information is provided for all subareas of the subtests taken on the test date indicated. Refer to the test framework for a description of subarea content.

5 Constructed-Response Information

Scorers judge the overall effectiveness of each response using a score scale and a set of performance characteristics. Refer to your score report and the preparation materials for more information.

6 Performance Indices

Performance indices provide information on your performance on each subarea and may help you assess your strengths and weaknesses.

7 Reporting
